

Rev. Jackie Dale Leathers

Rev. Jackie Dale Leathers was born on September 22, 1947 in Malden, Missouri to Charles Junior and Betty Jo (Belt) Leathers and passed away May 1, 2020, surrounded by his loving family at his home in Salem, Missouri at the age of seventy-two years.

Jackie grew up in Malden, Missouri and graduated with the class of 1964 from Bismarck High School. He went to further his education at Southwestern University and obtained his masters. On December 10, 1965 Jackie married the love of his life, Linda Marie Whitener in Bismarck, Missouri and together they shared fifty-four years of marriage and were blessed with three sons: Jackie Jr., Jeffry, and Allen.

Jackie entered the United States Army on September 4, 1979 and served his country faithfully until his retirement after twenty years of service.
