

Jesse James Asbridge May 2, 1943 - January 3, 2019

Jesse James "Jim" Asbridge was born May 2, 1943 in Dent County, Missouri to Othel "Buck" and Beatrice "Bea" (McCabe) Asbridge and passed away January 3, 2019 at his home at Jadwin, Missouri at the age seventy-five years.

Jim, as he was fondly known, grew up at Cedar Grove near Jadwin, Missouri and attended Summersville High School, he spent two years in the United States Army. Jim was of the Baptist Faith and was united in marriage to Carmalee Cathern Wood; to this union two children were born.
