and tough. Anna's family was very important to her and she valued spending time with them. Making memories with her grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren are times she treasured most.

Anna was a faithful member of Anutt Community Church where she enjoyed attending when she was able. Her generosity and kindness radiated brightly through her. She was also a member of the Lenox Homemakers' Club.

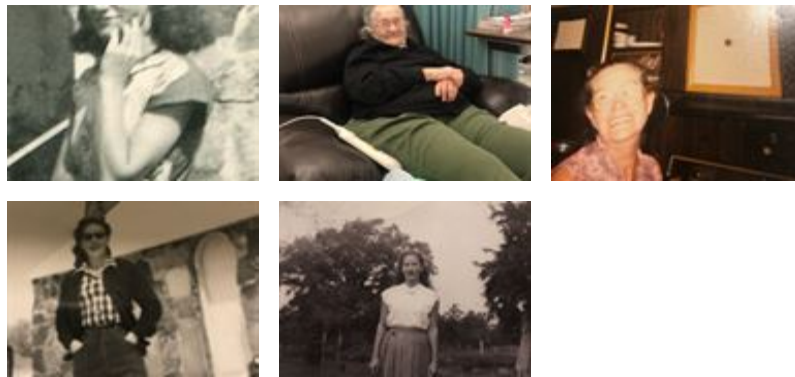
