



## Berniece "Sis" Lois (Pryor) Miner

Berniece "Sis" Lois (Pryor) Miner, the daughter of James Solomon and Zola Josephine (Davis) Pryor, was born December 1, 1936, in Boss, Missouri. She grew up in what she called, "Pryor Holler" along with her brothers, Lloyd and Paul "Tooter".

On August 29, 1958, Sis was united in marriage to the love of her life, James "Jim" Dwayne Miner. She was a dedicated wife to Jim for sixty-two years before his passing November 6, 2020, faithful mother to her children: Kimberlee, Timothy, and Tara, devoted grandmother to her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and affectionately known as Aunt Sis to her cherished nieces and nephews.

In her early twenties, she started working for Brown Shoe Factory for many years. She then started working at Absorbent Cotton until she retired in 2001. Her life was a testament to love, perseverance, and the dignity of hard work.

Sis was a big supporter of her children and grandchildren; she loved to attend their sports games and was their biggest fan. She loved taking family road trips, sightseeing at historical landmarks, and seeing the ocean for the first time at Virginia Beach. She also thoroughly enjoyed playing boardgames with her grandchildren, especially Dominos, Old Maid, and Aggravation.

Sis was an avid St. Louis Cardinals Baseball Fan, talented embroiderer and quilter, and loved listening to bluegrass and gospel music. When she was able, she worshipped at Faith Assembly of God and Boss Assembly of God. As her health declined, she started watching services online.

Berniece passed away September 12, 2025, surrounded by her loving family at her home, in High Ridge, Missouri, at the age of eighty-eight years. 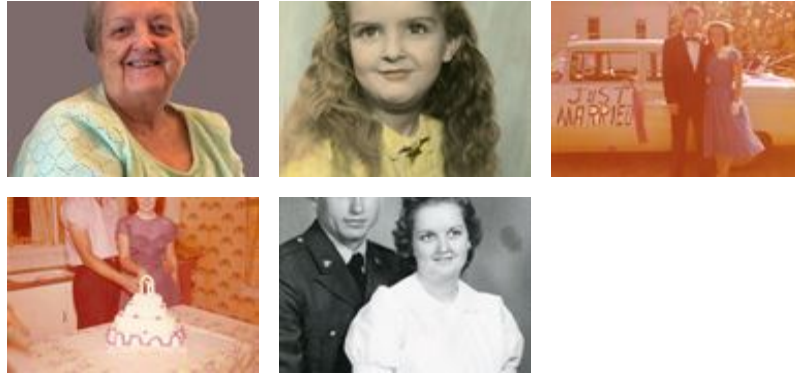
