In her younger years, Charlotte liked to bowl and loved line dancing. She really enjoyed crafting around the holidays. Charlotte was a lady of great faith and dedicated member of Salem First Baptist Church.

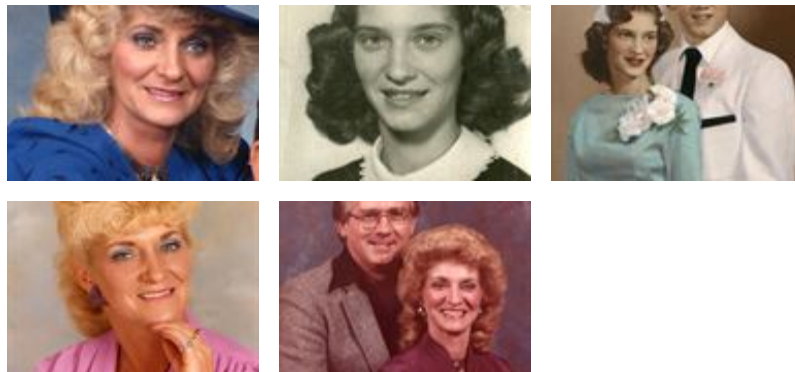
