Darrell Wayne Pryor was born November 15, 1941, in Crawford County, Missouri, to Lorian and Velma (Payne) Pryor. He passed away January 10, 2026, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of eighty-four years.

He attended Bixby Grade School and Valley of Caledonia High School. He was united in marriage to Betty Chandler on December 12, 1959, in Boss, Missouri, and three children were born to this union.

They moved to St. Louis where he worked at Angelica Uniform Company then at the Chrysler Assembly Plant. He didn't want to raise a family in the city so they bought a farm in Crawford County. 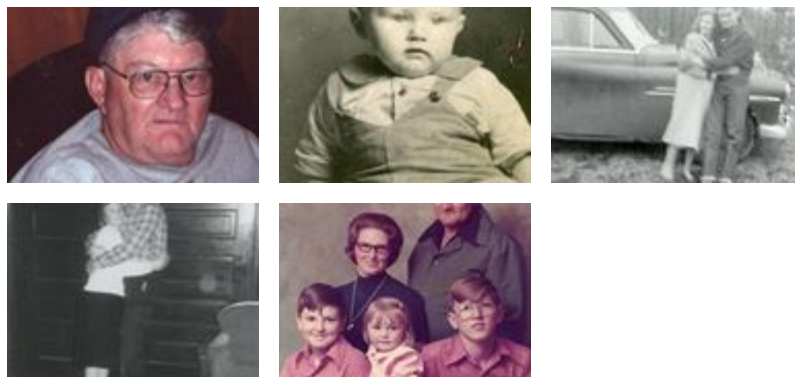
