



Donald "Pete" Halbrook

June 24, 1926 - September 1, 2024

Donald Wayne (Pete) Halbrook was born on June 24, 1926, in Salem, Missouri to Christopher Columbus and Rose Nell (Coulter) Halbrook. Pete was one of seven children and was raised on the family farm south of Salem. Pete graduated from Salem High School in 1945. At the time, World War II was in progress, so Pete enlisted in the U.S. Army even though he qualified for an exemption because all his brothers were already serving overseas. After the war ended and Pete was Honorably Discharged, he furthered his education and became a TV Technician. He began employment at Sears & Roebuck's in Kansas City, Missouri.

Pete was united in marriage to Marguerite (Lair) Hensley in 1955 and together shared sixty years of memories. Pete and Marguerite shared four children: Harold, Karon, Dana and Donnie.

In 1967 Pete and Marguerite left Kansas City and moved back to the farm where Pete was born and raised. For the next forty years they enjoyed wonderful lives raising cattle, farming and gardening.

In 2007 they retired from farming and moved to Branson, Missouri to be near their children and grandchildren.

Pete was a kindhearted and caring man. He always looked at the good in

others and was eager to help those in need. Pete was a devout Christian and served as a Deacon at Salem Church of Christ. He was actively involved in the community, serving on the Board of Education at Oakhill R-1 School, a Trustee for Miner Cemetery, helping at Livestock Auctions and working at the voting polls during elections. Pete was an avid sports fan. He coached Youth Baseball, was a dedicated spectator at his grandchildren's games and was a fan of the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team. Pete enjoyed quality time with his grandchildren, teaching them how to drive in the old pick-up truck, helping them pick and sell blackberries to make some spending money and telling them stories about his life experiences. In his latter years, Pete enjoyed playing the harmonica and spending lunchtime eating and socializing at the Senior Center in Branson.

Pete passed away on September 1, 2024, at the age of ninety-eight years. He leaves behind to cherish his memories; Children: Karon Matlock and husband Jim of Reeds Spring, MO and Donnie Halbrook and wife Priscilla of Branson, MO, twelve Grandchildren and a multitude of Great & Great-Great Grandchildren.

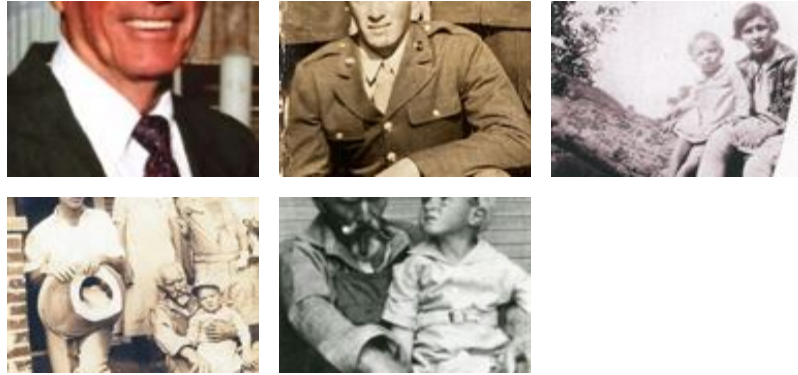
