Gary Allen Craig was born November 6, 1945, in St. Louis, Missouri. He was one of three sons born to Voris Everett and Ludie (Sanders) Craig. Gary was raised by his brother, Farris, and grew up in Salem where he attended Salem High School. Gary graduated from Wentworth Military Academy in Lexington, Missouri. He later furthered his education at Drury University where he obtained his bachelor's degrees.

On October 8, 1966, Gary enlisted into the United States Army. During his time in the military, he served during the Vietnam War and earned several decorations, medals, badges, ribbons, and awards. Gary was honorably discharged June 30, 1973, after seven years of dedication to his country.

Gary was united in marriage to, Janet Kay Atchison, on December 15, 1986, in Lake Tahoe, Nevada. They were blessed with nearly thirty-seven years of lasting memories together. Gary and Janet shared four children: Bryon, Brent, Melissa, and Cristie.

Gary worked in the family business, Craig Distributing, with his brothers until his retirement in 2000. He was an avid golfer and very active at the Spring Creek Golf Club. Gary was a man of great faith and lifelong member of Salem United Methodist Church.

Gary liked to garden, enjoyed fishing, and loved to spend time with his family making memories at the Lake of the Ozarks. His grandchildren and great-grandchildren were his world and brought him great joy. He truly enjoyed being called Papa or Grumpo.

Gary entered eternal rest on November 21, 2023, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of seventy-eight years. 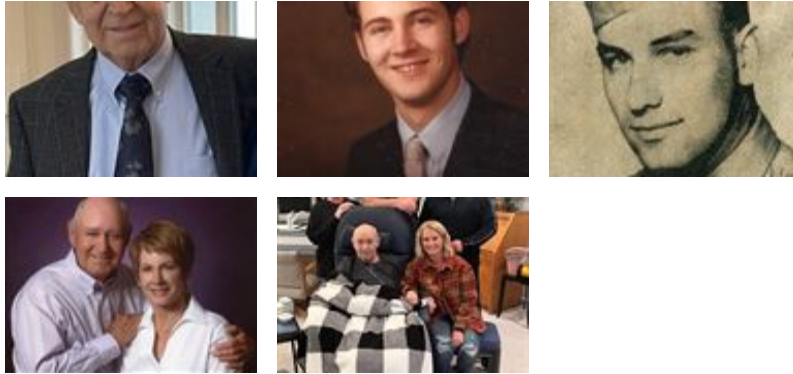
