Gloria Lee (Pace) Nash was born on December 7, 1942, in Salem, Missouri. She was one of three daughters of John Wilbern and Berniece (Johnson) Pace. Gloria grew up in Salem and graduated from Salem High School in 1963. She also lived in Chicago, IL, St. Charles, MO, and Rolla, MO, but she always returned to her beloved hometown, where she lived until she and her husband moved into an assisted living facility in Osage Beach, MO in January.

On August 1, 1965, she married the love of her life, Vertis Nash. Vertis's brother, Murl, united them in marriage in Salem. Together, they built a loving family, raising their twin sons, Keith and Kirk, along with their daughters, Kendra and Natalie. She was known for her quiet humor, boundless patience, and nurturing nature. Her grandchildren and great-grandson were her entire world; she treasured every moment spent with them.

A devoted homemaker and wife, Gloria had a genuinely caring heart, which was evident from an early age when she regularly took her four-year-old sister to school with her because it saddened her to leave her crying at home. Her caring spirit extended to others through years of babysitting. Affectionately called "Mammaw" by many, she had a giving heart that touched countless lives, enriching those around her throughout her life.

Gloria's skillful hands reflected her gentle nature. She learned to sew from her

grandmother at a young age, a skill she cherished and utilized beautifully, even crafting her daughter's bridal gown. If she knew you and found out you were having a baby, you were likely gifted a crocheted baby blanket, quilt, or tiny sweater set that became a treasured keepsake, each stitch filled with her love and care.

A longtime and active member of the Salem Church of Christ, Gloria was a Sunday School teacher and VBS helper. She shared her faith and kindness with her church family, whom she loved dearly.

Gloria passed away on April 12, 2025, in Osage Beach, Missouri, at the age of eighty-two. She will be deeply missed by her husband, Vertis Nash; her twin sons, Keith Nash and his wife Angie of Salem, MO, and Kirk Nash of Cuba, MO; her daughters, Kendra Nicholson and her husband Bradley of Walnut Grove, MO, and Natalie Beacom and her husband Aaron of Key West, FL; her sister, Gail Halbrook and her husband Ervin of Salem, MO; her grandchildren Glenn T. 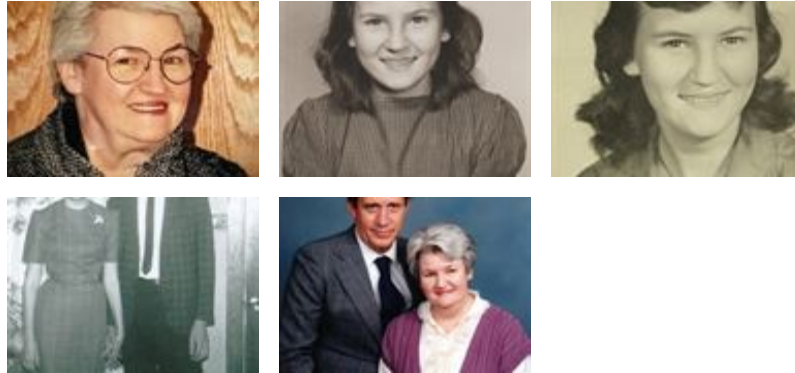
