Jackie Lee Allmon was born September 6, 1930, in Winona, Missouri, to William and Mattie (Atkins) Allmon. At a young age, he enlisted in the United States Army before starting his career with the United States Air Force. Jackie earned the rank of Senior Master Sergeant and retired after more than twenty-six years of outstanding meritorious service. Jackie served during the Korea and Vietnam War, for his faithful and honorable service, some of his decoration includes the Bronze Star, Commendation Medal with 1 Oak Leaf Cluster, Purple Heart, Presidential Unit Citation, and Outstanding Unit Award with V and 3 Oak Clusters.

Jackie was united in marriage to the love of his life, Martha Marie Greene, May 9, 1953, and to this union they were blessed with four children: Randy, Theresa, Sandra, and Jackie. Jackie and Martha were blessed to share forty-nine years of memories before her passing December 3, 2002. Jackie later married his sweetheart, Nancy, and shared together several years before her passing in 2009.

After retirement, Jackie started working for the National Park Service for many years. He enjoyed hunting and made several trips to Wyoming to hunt antelopes. Jackie loved to fish, especially in the Current River. He also liked to visit with friends. Most important to him was his family. He found pure happiness when spending time with his grandchildren and great-

grandchildren, their laughter filled every corner of his heart.

Jackie entered eternal rest September 8, 2023, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of ninety-three years. He is survived by his loving children: Randy Allmon and wife Norma of Chandler, AZ, Theresa Allmon of Salem, MO, Sandra Roffers and husband Gene of Big Spring, TX, and Jackie Sisco and husband Wade of Salem, MO; stepbrother: Frankie Van Winkle and wife Diane of Winona, MO; grandchildren: Juliet Metzler and husband Dan, Denver Blackwell and wife Jennifer, Dustin Blackwell and wife Christi, Dylan Sisco and wife Kala, Michael Roffers and wife Sherry, Megan Mason and husband Chris; great-grandchildren: Emerson, Truett, Jacob, Shanna, Devon, Hunter, Kailey, Xayden, ND, and Rivers; as well as several nieces, nephews, other relatives, and dear friends.
