James "Jim" Gilbert Smarko was born February 4, 1940, in St. Louis, Missouri to James and Theresa (Lang) Smarko. He grew up in St. Louis and graduated from McBride High School with the class of 1958. Jim enlisted into the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge. During his time in the military, he obtained rank as a sergeant and earned many medals, decorations, and awards.

Jim was united in marriage to Judy Layton in August 1962 and to this union blessed with five children: Eric, Jill, Deanna, Kirk, and Neil. He was a devoted father and took great pride in his family. 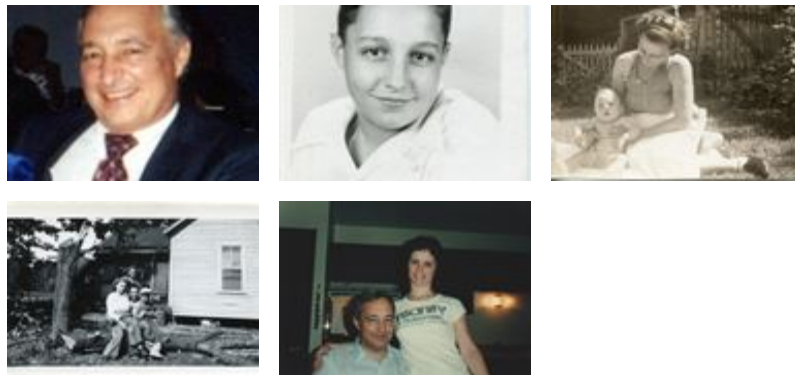
