



Joe Lee Hubbs

January 11, 1946 - July 12, 2024

Joe Lee Hubbs was born January 11, 1946, to Claude William and Lois Maxine (Westerman) Hubbs. He grew up in Salem, Missouri and graduated with the class of 1963 from Salem High School. After high school, he enlisted in the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge January 5, 1972.

While stationed in Washington D.C., Joe met the love of his life, Cynthia Gail Lynn. They were united in marriage on November 25, 1967, and shared fifty-four years of lasting memories before her passing April 10, 2022. Joe and Gail were blessed with three sons: Joseph, William, and Matthew.

Joe, a skilled upholsterer, spent a large part of his working career in a shop based out of his home. His work was excellent, and he upholstered many couches, chairs, workbenches, etc. throughout the years. In his spare time, Joe loved making memories with his family. He truly enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren and especially loved hunting and fishing with them.

Joe was a quiet man of few words, but when he spoke, people listened. His faith was strong, and he had a heart for serving and telling others about the Lord. Joe served as the Pastor of Dry Fork Baptist Church for over thirty years.

Joe entered eternal rest July 12, 2024, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of seventy-eight years. 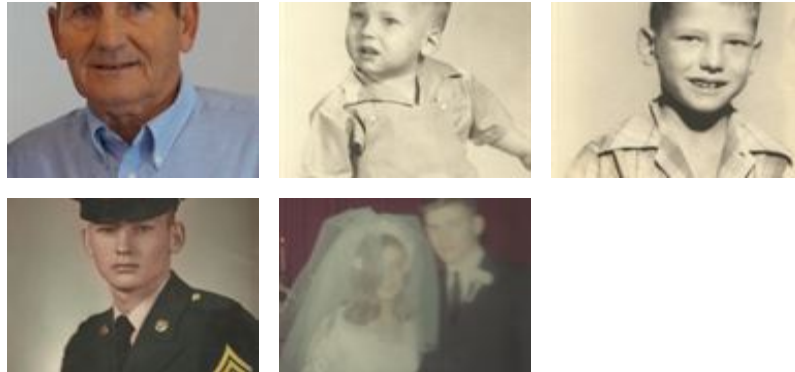
