Joel Anthony Williams was born April 10, 1970 in Wheatfield, Illinois to Joe and Gail (Campbell) Williams. He grew up in Goodman, Missouri and graduated with the class of 1988 from Neosho High School. After high school, Joel entered the United States Marine Corp and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge. During his time in the military, Joel earned many decorations, medals, badges, ribbons, and awards and served during Operation Desert Storm.
