Kenneth Edward Washausen was born November 22, 1943, in St. Louis, Missouri. He was one of two sons born to Wilbur Eugene and Bernice Charlotte Marie (Roever) Washausen. He grew up in Valmeyer, Illinois and graduated from Valmeyer High School.

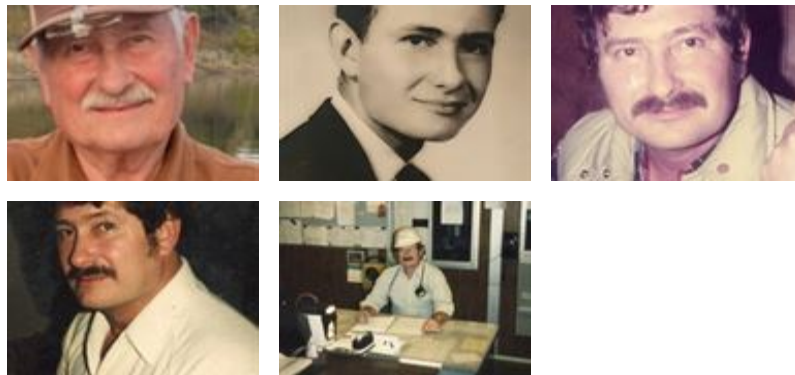
