Lloyd Alvin Lunn was born February 7, 1938, in Rhyse, Missouri, to Raymond and Virginia (Floyd) Lunn. He grew up in Licking, Missouri, and graduated in 1955 from Licking High School. After high school, he served honorably in the Army National Guard for fourteen years.

Lloyd was united in marriage to the love of his life, Ina Arlene Shults, June 3, 1960, in Salem, Missouri. They built a beautiful life together sharing sixty-three years of lasting memories. Lloyd and Arlene were blessed with three sons: Gary, Mike, and Brad.

Lloyd was a man of faith and baptized June 18, 1978, at the Second Baptist Church in Salem, Missouri. He was a dedicated member of Salem First

Baptist Church and attended faithfully until his health no longer allowed.

Lloyd entered eternal rest on November 27, 2023, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of eighty-five years.
