Louie Elmer Stagner, the son of Earl Lee and Estella Rebecca (Needy) Stagner, was born July 22, 1945, in Dent County, Missouri. He enlisted into the United States Air Force August 9, 1962, and served faithfully until honorable discharge August 8, 1966. On June 7, 1969, Louie was united in marriage to Linda Gail Sisco.

Louie and Linda were blessed to have four children: Brent Lee, Tim, Tom, Tricia. Despite facing difficulties early on with their first birth, their lives were greatly enriched by their children. When grandchildren joined the family, they were overjoyed. Their fifty-six years of marriage was filled with love, laughter, and remarkable memories.

A devoted worker throughout his life, Louie worked as a letter carrier with the United States Postal Service until his retirement. He later went to work in the mail department at Phelps County Bank for ten years. In his spare time, he enjoyed spending time outdoors. His younger years, he could be found deer and turkey hunting.

His faith, family, and friends were most important to him. Louie loved spending quality time with his family, especially his grandchildren whom he cherished beyond measure. Louie and Linda enjoyed attending Grace Assembly of God Church, until they moved to Rolla and then eventually to Springfield, where

they attended Springfield Vineyard Church.

Louie entered into Heaven June 24, 2025, in Springfield, Missouri, at the age of seventy-nine years.
