Orville Eugene Swearingin was born December 29, 1933, in Elk Head, Missouri, to Lora and Cordelia (Willis) Swearingin. He grew up in Ongo, Missouri, and graduated from the Chadwick School District. After high school, Orville attended auctioneering school and became an auctioneer for many years.

On April 9, 1955, Orville was united in marriage to the love of his life, Pauline Ceola Hawkins. They shared sixty-nine years of marriage and lasting memories together. Orville and Pauline were blessed with five children: Beulah, Karen, Pamela, Douglas, and Dallas.

Orville started his working career as a Green's Keeper with Hickory Hills Country Club in Springfield, Missouri until the Ava Country Club opened. In 1968, he started working for Spring Creek Golf Course, in Salem, Missouri, until his retirement after twenty-eight years of dedication.

After retirement, Orville started farming and working cattle. He enjoyed the farming life for twenty-eight years. In his spare time, he liked to go to Montauk to camp and trout fish. Orville and Pauline loved going to the Lake of the Ozarks to camp and crappie fish.

Orville admired his family and cherished spending time making memories with

his grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren. He was a man of strong faith and longtime member of Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church. Throughout the years he served as a deacon, treasurer, and song leader.

Orville entered into eternal rest April 12, 2024, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of ninety years. He is survived by his loving wife: Pauline Swearingin of Salem, MO; daughters: Beulah Chilton of Salem, MO, Karen Hogan and husband David of Salem, MO, and Pamela Todd and husband Jack of Salem, MO; a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren; sister-in-law: Marie Schuenemann; brother-in-law: Jerry Hawkins and wife Janice; extended family and dear friends.
