Remey Richard Ratliff was born August 26, 1947, to Alec and Wanda (Thomas) Ratliff. He was born and raised in Frenchburg, Kentucky. Remey enlisted in the United States Navy and served his country faithfully until his honorable discharge.

On November 7, 1969, Remey was united in marriage to Diana Lee Keller while in Denver, Colorado. They shared the last fifty-four years creating lasting memories together. Remey and Diana were blessed with two daughters: Rena and Chantay.
