Richard Dewayne Overby was born August 19, 1965, in Columbia, Missouri. He was the only son of Richard and Wilma (Smith) Overby. Richard grew up and attended school in Salem, Missouri.

On May 24, 1997, he was united in marriage to Jackie Nash, and to this union was blessed with one daughter, Brittney. He was a devoted and proud father.

Richard was a talented and respected auto body collision expert. He was currently working at Wilson Collision Center, previously known as Larson Collision Center. For a time, Richard owned his own shop, Overby Auto Body.

Richard loved and was skilled in woodworking and found great joy in making furniture. He also enjoyed woodcarving. He had a love for the outdoors and liked going fishing, hunting, and riding his motorcycle.

Richard loved his family and would do anything for them. He valued the time spent with his children and grandchildren. His family, faith, and friends were the most important parts of his life. Richard gave his heart to the Lord, June 18, 2021, the day of his father's funeral.

Richard departed this life August 18, 2024, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of fifty-eight years. Those left behind to treasure his memory include his loving

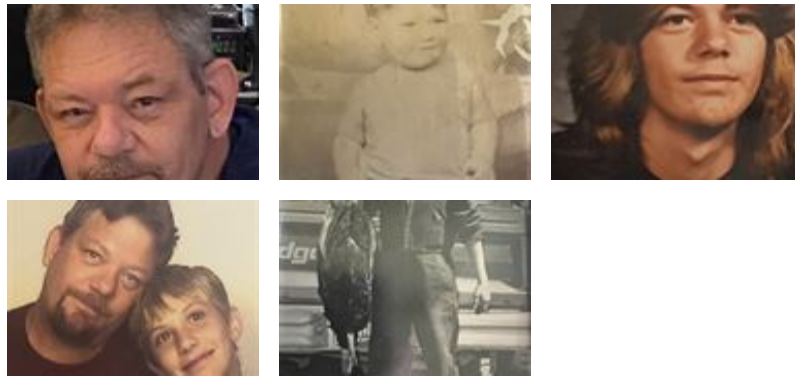
