Scott Allen Huff was born on November 16, 1966, in Fredericktown, Missouri, to Ronald and Ann (Bowen) Huff. He grew up in Boss and graduated from Viburnum High School in 1985. Scott furthered his education at Missouri State University and the University of Missouri -Rolla, earning his associate degree.

On December 5, 1990, Scott was united in marriage to Trish Redding, and together they were blessed with two sons, Austin and Blake. Scott and Trish built a life filled with love and dedication to their family. They shared twenty-five wonderful years together before her passing on November 2, 2015.

spoke for him. He was always willing to lend a helping hand and was known for his thoughtfulness and generosity. Above all, his family was most important to him. 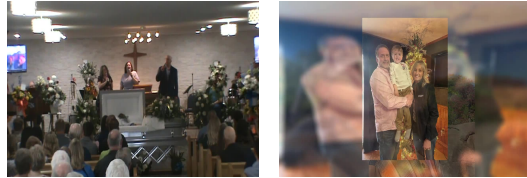

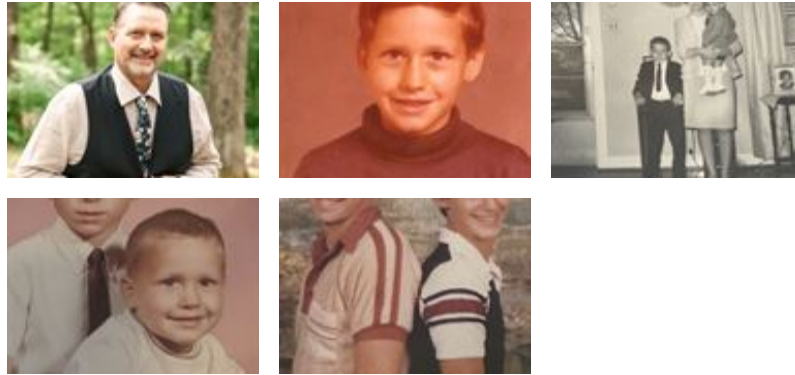
