Stanley Ray Barton was born August 10, 1949, in St. Louis, Missouri, to Ray and Irmaleen (Turner) Barton. He was one of two children and grew up on the family farm in Bixby, Missouri. Stanley graduated in 1967 from Valley of Caledonia High School and furthered his education with Mineral Area College. He served faithfully and honorably in the United States Army for two years.

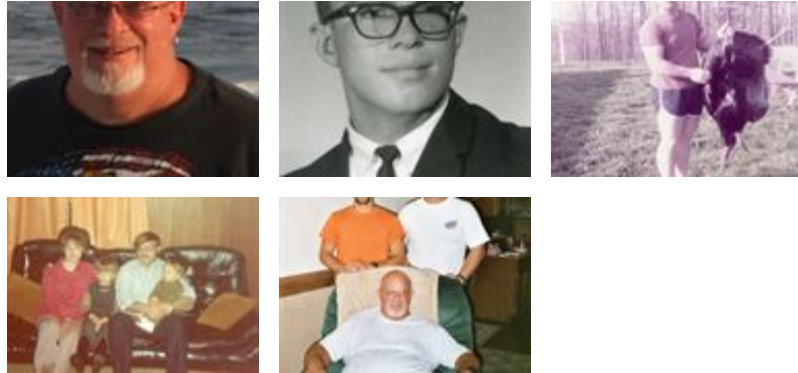
