Steven Wade Pines was born on March 7, 1943, in St. Louis, Missouri, to Howard and Bobbie (nee Ball) Pines and passed away on July 20, 2022, in Phoenix, Arizona, at age seventy-nine.

Steven grew up in Salem, Missouri, and attended Salem High School, graduating in 1961. He attended college briefly, and he loved learning throughout his life. For many years, Steven worked as the bookkeeper at Pines Chevrolet Company. In addition, Steven was active in the Salem United Methodist Church where he taught Sunday School.
