Pat enjoyed trail riding and was the trail leader at Golden Hills Trail Rides in Raymondville, Missouri for many years. His love for the outdoors was evident in his passion for hunting and spending time on the farm.

Music and poetry were something he was gifted at and enjoyed sharing with

others. He has written several poems and even had some published. Pat also wrote several gospel song lyrics, as well as played the guitar and harmonica. He was a man of great faith and attended Dent County House of Prayer. He was a previous a member of Greeley Community Church and Crossville Baptist Church.

Pat departed this life July 6, 2024, surrounded by his loving family at his home in Salem, Missouri, at the age of eighty-five years.
