Thomas "Aldie" Alden Christesen was born September 25, 1943, in Hutchinson, Kansas to Paul Thomas and Ruth Leola (McCreight) Christesen. Aldie grew up in Lyndon, Kansas and graduated in 1961 from Lyndon High School. After graduating, Aldie joined the Army Reserves and served faithfully for four years.

Aldie fell in love with his sweetheart, Carolyn McWhorter, and proposed to her thru a letter. On August 14, 1971, they were united in marriage sharing together fifty-two years of laughter and memories. Aldie and Carolyn were blessed with two sons: Mark and Philip and later blessed with six grandchildren. He deeply loved his family and loved making memories with them. Aldie was a devoted husband, dedicated father, and proud grandfather.

Aldie was a skilled carpenter and woodworking was his passion. He owned and operated Aldie's Cabinet Shop for many years. His love of woodworking and carpentry skills shined in all the fine cabinets he built. He never let a piece of wood go untouched without creating something useful. Before moving to Salem, Missouri in 2009, Aldie managed Lyndon Building Materials for several years.

Aldie lived a very humble and simple life and loved to dedicate his time and talent to help others. He served as municipal judge, councilman, and mayor in

Lyndon, Kansas. He had a servant's heart and was very active with Mt. Pleasant Community Church in Kansas. During his membership he served as deacon, bus driver, and taught Sunday School. Aldie was a member of Salem First Baptist Church and liked to fellowship with others. He truly enjoyed reading his Bible and also served in The Gideons International Ministry.

Aldie entered into eternal rest on June 30, 2022, at his home in Salem, Missouri at the age of seventy-nine years. 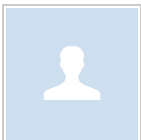

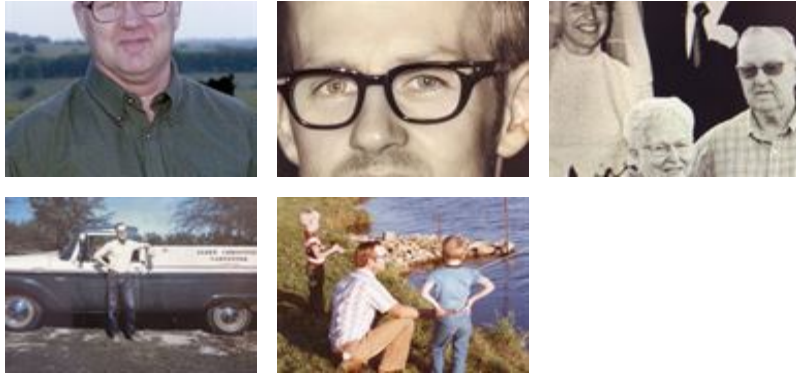
