Thomas Joseph Schlipp was born on January 22, 1946, in Franklin County, Missouri to Lawrence and Margaret (Dorlac) Schlipp and passed away on September 21, 2020, at Cox South Medical Center in Springfield at age of seventy-four years.

Tom's early years were spent in St. Clair then the family moved to Illinois for a year. When Tom was about 10 years of age, his family made the move to Salem and that became the place he would call home. Tom was united in marriage to Wilda "Claudine" Robnett on November 26, 1971, at St. Jude's Church near Montauk and together they were blessed to share three children.

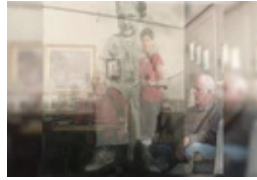

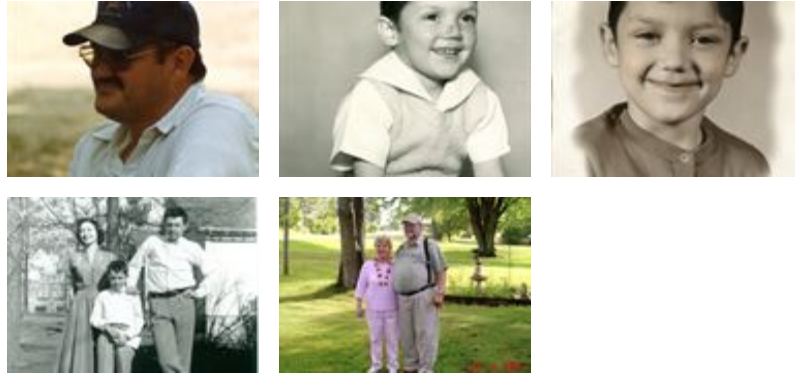
