Vardel Ray Wisdom was born March 27, 1934, in Boss, Missouri. He was one of two sons born to Gurney and Lola (Clements) Wisdom. He grew up on the family farm in Boss and graduated with the class of 1952 from Caledonia High School.

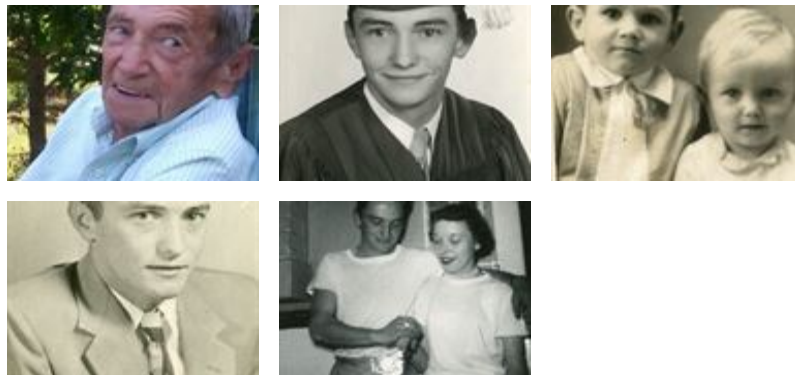
