Velma had an effervescent personality and would brighten anyone's day she came across. Her passion and vigor for life was contagious. She had a great love of genealogy, art, fashion, music, cooking, entertaining, gardening, and real estate, which she never stopped teaching to those around her.

Velma entered into eternal rest February 26, 2024, in Salem, Missouri, at the age of eighty-seven years. Those left behind to treasure her memory include a host of loving nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives, and dear friends.

Preceding her in death were her loving husband: William E. Rohrer; and parents: William and Belle (Hall) Eudy.
